Mission Amplify is an advocacy training initiative that gives congregations and community groups step-by-step guidance for engaging state and local elected officials.

MISSION AMPLIFY:

- Shows our leaders that people of faith firmly support public education.
- Moves people to reach beyond charitable giving to make the systemic changes that will benefit and sustain all children.
- Strengthens our collective voice in demanding a school system that fulfills student needs.
- Provides an accessible first step into advocacy and sets the stage for continuing support of children's issues at the ballot box and beyond.



WHY do public school children need the support of faith communities?

The public school system is our collective, common good, serving 90% of children in the U.S. — yet many students are NOT receiving what they need to flourish and realize their God-given potential.

It's time for our congregations, guided by faith, morality, and justice, to advocate for all children, particularly those with the greatest need, including children who are:

- Black, Hispanic/Latinx, or Indigenous
- living in rural areas or high-poverty urban areas
- from low-income families
- with physical, emotional, or learning differences
- who speak a different language at home
- who lack access to early education (birth-to-age 5) programs like Pre-K



THE MISSION:

Build statewide networks of trained advocates who regularly engage elected officials in support of public education.

Quality public education not only serves the best interest of our children, but is also essential for the prosperity of our communities in preparing young people for their civic and workforce responsibilities.



How does Mission Amplify work?

Mission Amplify informs congregations about public education issues and explains how to demand solutions from state legislators and other elected officials via letter writing, social media, and personal visits.

1. LEARN about public school needs

Topics are presented as a season of six episodes, along with devotionals for context and inspiration.

2. COMMUNICATE with elected officials

Instructions are provided for writing to and meeting with state senators and representatives.

3. EXPAND advocacy efforts

Additional actions are encouraged, including contacting other officials and voting for candidates who support public education.



Children represent the promise of the future — but that future depends on how well we shoulder responsibility for their care, protection, and nurturing.

The Mission Amplify curriculum can be:

- Part of an existing class or Bible study group, or be held during or after worship.
- A stand-alone program that uses the devotional to promote further discussion of Scripture related to the episode.
- Used by secular groups by simply excluding the devotional.

Benefits for program participants:

- Establishes relationships between constituents and elected officials.
- Strengthens group fellowship by working toward a common goal.
- Gives a tangible sense of progress on issues that directly impact children in the local community.
